After a minibus transfer from your hotel to the Vaiare dock, you will be taken by boat to [Motu Ahi's lagoonarium](#) on the east coast of the island. Led by a qualified instructor, you will encounter a multitude of fish in absolute freedom: tropical fish (surgeonfish, tangs, parrotfish, butterflyfish, damselfish etc.), giant kingfish, moray eels, stingrays and blacktip reef sharks, and more... Watch their "daddy" Teiki feed them and play with his little brood... It is a show not to be missed! You can also discover the small motu, furnished with local odds and ends, a world of its own... For even more comfort, the latest generation of masks are available to visitors: enjoy snorkeling without the inconvenience of water in your mask or snorkel (careful! limited numbers).

Temaeva dance troupe, big winner of the Heiva 2015!

Created in 1962, this emblematic dance group of Tahiti has received numerous awards at the Heiva. Its leader Coco Hotahota has directed hundreds of dancers among whom many are recognized artists (Makau Foster, Fabien Dinard etc...). An avant-gardist master of art, Hotahota is also a father to the evolution of the "Ori Tahiti", or Tahitian traditional dance, combining innovation and respect of the traditions, thus preserving authenticity in his performances to never forget his roots.

This year, Temaeva has offered us a colorful performance filled with dynamism and sensuality. Its vibrant choir, dazzling costumes, powerful traditional orchestra, and stunning performers have taken us to a festive and graceful world.

Hotahota and his talented chief choreographer, Rita Tauhere, have given back to the Heiva its authentic and original identity transmitting in their show the simplicity of the Polynesian lifestyle and the joie de vivre of our islands!

Niyati Sailing Dive Cruises starting from Raiatea

Valerie and Jeep, who will welcome you aboard the sailboat Niyati, are the vessel's owners and the masters on board! Jeep is a level 4 diver, an experienced sailor, and captain of the Niyati. He manages the maintenance of the boat, and handles safety on board and on the surface during dives. Valerie is a state-certified 2nd degree diving instructor, and is also qualified to supervise the disabled. Both sailed and dived in the South Seas for several years before anchoring in Polynesia. After being here for the past 6 years, they already know the most beautiful dive sites in the Leeward Islands and are true enthusiasts, always looking for new sites.

The boat, a 15.40 meter-long monohull Bavaria 49, designed specifically for diving, is equipped for "cruising": satellite phone, beacon, radar, watermaker, solar panels, wind turbine... Light and comfortable, it lets you get as close to dive sites as possible before going to the descent point with the tender. Equipped with only 2 guest cabins, it will welcome you for an almost private cruise for a minimum itinerary of 4 nights.

Particular attention is paid to passenger's comfort and safety: outings are scheduled to ensure less crowds at the sites, and Valérie is equipped with a submersible VHF radio for contacting the boat in case of an emergency upon surfacing. The Scubapro diving equipment used is replaced under agreement every 2 years. Languages spoken: English, French, Italian, and German!

Experienced divers, beginners, and even non-divers, you are all welcome on the Niyati, to explore the undersea world and the Polynesian islands. Private, semi-private or Prestige packages, with an additional hostess on board, you can choose your cruise option!
