### **Scuba Diving in Tahaa**

Less known for diving than the Tuamotu Archipelago or Bora Bora, the island of Tahaa is home to some beautiful, yet rarely visited dive sites. Discover Paipai and Ceran passes or the Octopus Hole... where sharks, turtles, surgeonfish and other tropical fish can be found in numbers.

Located on the motu (islet) of the 5\* Hotel Le Taha'a Island Resort & Spa, the Tahaa Diving Center offers quick access to the outer reef of the west coast of the island, which is often sheltered from the eastern wind.

One same lagoon for two islands... the diving center also offers diving trips to Raiatea, in particular to the shipwreck site of the Nordby, a Danish three-masted metal ship built in 1873 and sunk in the early 1900s by the Mara'amu, the southeasterly tradewind known here for its strength.

2 tank dive in the morning, single or introductory dive in the afternoon... open 7 days a week... and diving equipment replaced recently!

### **SPM Hotels - Change in 2015 Conditions for Children**

Conditions for Children in 2015 have recently been revised in the SPM hotels on Moorea, Bora Bora, and Tikehau.

While the initial terms provided for free accommodation for Children aged 5-14 years sharing the room with their parents, any rollaway bed added to the existing bed configuration in the bungalow will now be charged at a fixed rate at each of these three hotels.

Applicable on all new bookings.

### **Tahaa, Boutique Lodge Fare Pea Iti – Room Category closed from January 01st, 2016**

The "Room" category will no longer be available starting January 01st, 2016. It will be converted into a transit room (free and available based on the lodge occupancy) and a massage room (also available in bungalow, payable on-site).

### **Bora Bora, Pension EcoLodge Anau – Rate for Triple corrected**

Due to a clerical error, the 3rd person supplement had not been taken into account; we therefore had to revise the Triple Family Bungalow rate upwards (+17%). We apologize for any inconvenience.

 **Moorea, Pension Village Temanoha – Shuttle Fare Miti discontinued**

The latest addition into our list for Moorea, Pension Village Temanoha offers a unique natural experience in the heart of the Caldera, in a huge park with fruit trees, such as grapefruit, banana, guava, orange, but also giant bamboo, aito, etc. A mini holiday village where pleasant wood and stone chalets are built around the pool/jacuzzi/snack area; this exotic mountain place is a nice change when making a multi-island circuit including mainly other accommodations by the lagoon.

Run by the same managers as Pension Fare Miti, the Village Temanoha previously operated a daily shuttle between the two pensions, offering guests the opportunity to enjoy the beautiful beach of Fare Miti. Too constraining, the pension unfortunately no longer provides this service. However, it still offers a free transfer from one pension to the other, provided the guests are staying a minimum of 2 nights in each of these two pensions.
