Throughout the journey, your guide will make various stops significant to the history of the city to add an educational touch to your ride.

- Papeete Discovery 2h30

More complete, this tour offers a combination the "Papeete Evasion" route and a discovery of the heart of the city, its shops, its market and its institutions. Since Seqways are considered pedestrians, the exploration is safely undertaken by the sidewalks of the city.

- Papeete by Night 1h30

With friends or as a couple, wander at dusk along the Marina illuminated by a



beautiful turquoise blue, until he famous place Vaiete and its food trucks (mobile restaurants) and why not pick out the one where you want to have a good dinner at after the tour!

Each service is a chance for discovery, exchanges, and romance. The Polynesian priest will bless your union with the sounds of traditional instruments and songs, while the colorful costumes of the







dancers will blend together to the Maohi rhythms.

The Brando – Air Tetiaroa Conditions Revised & Reminders

Please note that for any Air Tetiaroa flight departing from Tahiti,

- Passengers must arrive at check in at least 45 minutes before take-off (versus 20min previously)
- The minimum layover time between an Air Tahiti flight and an Air Tetiaroa flight is now 75min (versus 45min previously)

These changes are to be taken into account for all bookings, with the exception of confirmed bookings with Air Tahiti flight mentioned.



Also, as indicated in the sales document, we remind you that the Guest Information Form is MANDATORY. 2 formats are available:

- PDF format available on our Sales Document, to be filled out by the customer and returned to us by fax or email.
- A hyperlink to send to customers will be sent to you with the booking confirmation. The document, once filled out by the customers, will be automatically sent to the Brando.

Due to its location on a remote island, it is very important, for the comfort of our mutual customers, to transmit the hotel all important information about them in advance, such as Food Allergies and other particulars.

We want to issue a little reminder about the Resort Fee, payable on-site at two major hotels on the island of Tahiti:

Hotel Manava Suite Resort Tahiti 3*

Resort Fee: 1250 XPF (10.47 Euros) per ROOM, per NIGHT

Hotel Tahiti Pearl Beach Resort 4*

Resort Fee: 1800 XPF (15.08 Euros) per ROOM, per NIGHT (or day use)

We thank you in advance for reminding visitors planning to stay in these establishments that this fee cannot be pre-paid in advance and that they must pay it on site upon check out.
