NEW in Rangiroa! Partnership with Pension Bounty

Hosted by Muriel and Alain (a Level 3 diver), let yourself be lulled by the calm and tranquility of this charming establishment in Rangiroa. Organized into four comfortable studios with European standards, it focuses on letting its guests have their independence. Indeed, each studio is equipped with a kitchenette, a bathroom with hot water, a safe, a ceiling fan, a large deck, an extra bed on request, free wi-fi access, and mosquito nets on the doors and windows. To complete the picture, the pension has a white sandy beach, a rarity on Rangiroa; bicycles are available free of charge, ideal for trips to the village of Avatoru and other sites, where the beautiful sunsets will enchant you.

Some restrictions to keep in mind:

- Blackout from June 30 to October 26: during this period, the Single rate is not applicable, and bookings for multiple units are not accepted
- Children under 12 are not allowed at the pension
- A strict cancellation policy to keep in mind, with fees applied for any cancellation after a booking is confirmed.

Hotel Hibiscus 2* on Moorea: Pool closed for repairs

Following a major water leak caused by the roots of two large royal poinciana trees, Hotel Hibiscus needs to close its swimming pool for repairs **from November 22 to December 30, 2015**.

Guests with bookings already confirmed for a stay during this period will be accommodated as far as possible from the construction noise. In addition, they will receive compensation upon arrival: a voucher for a free pizza per person at the hotel restaurant.

Note! New bookings for this period, received from today onwards will not receive this compensation and will be handled on a case-by-case basis once on site.

The affected bookings are currently being processed; our booking agents will be in touch with you if applicable.



Hotel Le Méridien Bora Bora 5* – Sea turtles under quarantine

Because of their health condition, the turtles are being temporarily quarantined in a specially adapted treatment center located within the Ecological Center. The public feeding of turtles is nevertheless maintained, followed by a visit of the Center. The other programs are also still available.

The purpose of Le Méridien Bora Bora Turtle Center is to collect injured sea turtles and care for them so that they may eventually be returned to their natural environment.

Car rental, or how to discover the islands in a different way

Be sure to request it from your travel agent. Please note, this form does not exempt you from having to present your driver's license on-site on D-day.

Bora Bora: St Regis & Four Seasons – Easing Conditions in 2016

We are pleased to announce that the **St. Regis Bora Bora Resort 5*** has eased the following conditions of its 2016 contract:

- **Breakfast** now included for all occupants of the villa, adults and children alike.
- In all **Stay/Pay offers** including a free night, every additional person now also receives the free night.
- Guests are no longer obligated to reserve the same **meal plan** for the duration of their stay.
- **Cancellation Policy:** we no longer require a systematic deposit at time of booking, but we reserve the right to request one in certain situations.

At the Four Seasons Bora Bora Resort 5*

The cancellation policy outside the festive season is also eased for all categories other than the Luxury Otemanu 3BR Beachfront Villa with Pool: the hotel now charges a fee for any cancellation within 30 days of check-in (rather than from the day right after the booking is confirmed!). We no longer require a systematic deposit at time of booking, but we reserve the right to request one in certain situations.

Pre-payment is still required for the Luxury Otemanu 3BR Beachfront Villa with Pool, with deposit retained for cancellation up to 61 days before (as opposed to 60 previously).



Other Updates: Family Pensions & Excursions

Tahaa, Pension Au Phil du Temps

In the Package of 3 nights with half-board excluding transfers, with excursions included (Island tour and organic vanilla plantation + Visit to a pearl farm + Guided tour of a coral garden), during the pearl farm visit, a free pearl is no longer offered. Bora Bora, Restaurant Maikai

Following an increase in the cost of transfers, the Poerava Dinner rate is increasing by about 3%, the child menu rate remains unchanged. Applicable to all new 2015 and 2016 booking requests.
